Applications are now being accepted for the George V, Homer E, and David R Woodling/Midtown Sertoma Club of Tucson Memorial Scholarship for the 2019-2020 academic year. Reese and Nancy Woodling established this scholarship to support the education of SLHS audiology students enrolled in the PhD or AuD program. - Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher and demonstrated scholastic excellence
- Financial need (FAFSA not required)
- Previous awardees may apply for a one-year renewal

Applicants should submit the following material by Friday, March 22nd, at 5:00 PM:

- Application form (second page of this document)
- Resume listing past honors and awards, past or current scholarships, community or school-related activities, memberships, and/ or work experience
- Personal statement describing your personal attributes, unique qualities, and goals (not more than one page)
- Letter of recommendation from one faculty member in the UA Department of Speech, Language, and Hearing Sciences (she/he will send letter directly to Dana Eriksson)
- A statement of financial need

Awarding process:

- Applications are due by Friday, March 22nd, at 5:00 PM, submitted in Room 214.
- All applicants will be notified when selections are finalized, which is typically by the end of April or early May.
- A thank you note from awardee to donor(s) is strongly encouraged.
